

# Arbíos

## 2004 Cabernet Sauvignon



WINERY:	After a notable winemaking career with many prominent wineries, Bill Arbíos fulfilled a longstanding dream of having his own label with the debut of Arbíos Cellars in 1993. Arbíos Cellars focuses on a single Bordeaux-style red wine, made from 100 percent cabernet sauvignon grapes grown in the acclaimed Alexander valley of Sonoma County. Although Bill has a successful track record crafting blended wines, he now prefers the additional challenges and artistry that go into making wine from a single vineyard. Placing the emphasis on terroir, Bill believes in honoring the character of the fruit without over-manipulating the wine.
DESCRIPTION:	The Bordeaux-style Cabernet Sauvignon is crafted to have moderate alcohol and good fruit character. Winemaker and owner Bill Arbíos likes to be "honest" with the fruit, avoiding overripe characteristics. The 2004 vintage is classic ruby red in color with purple highlights. Berry, cherry and plum aromas are followed by hints of clove, allspice and vanilla. The cherry is also woven into the wine's flavor and is complemented by notes of toffee, chocolate and forest floor.
