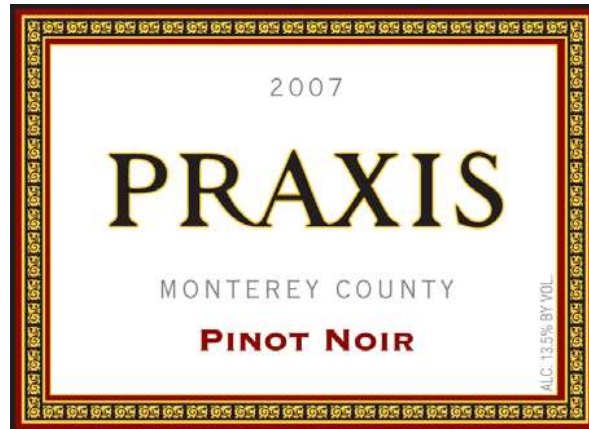


# Praxis

## 2007 Monterey Pinot Noir



### WINERY

After a notable winemaking career with many prominent wineries, Bill Arbiós fulfilled a longstanding dream of having his own label with the debut of Arbiós Cellars in 1993. Arbiós Cellars focuses on a single Bordeaux-style red wine, made from 100 percent Cabernet Sauvignon grapes grown in the acclaimed Alexander Valley of Sonoma County. In addition the second label - Praxis - features wines made from single varietals.

### DESCRIPTION:

This is their sixth vintage of Pinot Noir and their second from this vineyard in Monterey. The color is a deep garnet hue with purple overtones. The wine brims with aromas of Bing cherries, ripe plums, black currant, cola and vanilla. Flavors of strawberries and cassis are elegantly balanced in this soft and silky wine. The wine has a rich texture and is velvety and full bodied. Very well integrated tannins pair nicely with the bright acidity of the wine.

2100 cases - 750 ml

### COOPERAGE:

7 months in French oak barrels

### ANALYSIS

13.5% alcohol by volume; residual sugar 0.04%, pH 3.62, TA 0.59 gm/100ml
