Roger Wisted invented "California Blackjack" and established and grew the Blackjack Ranch Winery on the royalties starting in 1996. Using the finest location, rootstock and winemaking techniques he produces excellent wines that are well regarded by Robert Parker and many High Rollers. The winery appeared in the movie "Sideways" because the film director is a fan of these wines.

DESCRIPTION:

Layer upon layer upon layer of big, bold tarry black and blue fruit. Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot, and Petit Verdot all shine making the '04 a little Right Bank-like and a little Left Bank-like. Elegant, extraordinary nuances of black cherry extract are highlighted by espresso, black truffles, cassis, blueberries, and the slightest hint of old fashioned black licorice. French oak all the way. Drinking well already, tannins are there but not dominant. The 2004 Harmonie will drink well and be highly enjoyable for 10 to 20 years. When it starts to pick up bottle nuances, look out.
