

2006 Sauvignon Blanc



WINERY:

Located in Placerville, the Boeger Winery is 15 minutes from where gold was first discovered in 1849. The subsequent rush to the foothills brought many miners and immigrants to the area. Boeger Winery sits on an 1850's ranch and winery homesteaded by the Fossati-Lombardo family. The original house, cellar, and distillery are still used today.

In 1972 Greg and Sue Boeger bought the property. In the three decades since then they have built on their education and experience and are able to control the quality of their wines because they own or manage the 5 vineyards that provide over 90% of their grapes. They are small enough to allow full attention to detail.

DESCRIPTION:

2005 Sauvignon Blanc has aromas of Pineapple, orange, lemon, banana, some floral notes & a hint of spice. The wine has flavors that are predominantly citrus fruit flavors with some hints of tropical fruit and melon. The palate is crisp and lean through and through with a lingering finish. Great wine by itself, especially in warmer weather.

Will pair well with a variety of fish and light sauces. Will pair well with lemon and Alfredo sauces.
