WINERY:	Located in Placerville, the Boeger Winery is 15 minutes from where gold was first discovered in 1849. The subsequent rush to the foothills brought many miners and immigrants to the area. Boeger Winery sits on an 1850's ranch and winery homesteaded by the Fossati-Lombardo family. The original house, cellar, and distillery are still used today. In 1972 Greg and Sue Boeger bought the property. In the three decades since then they have built on their education and experience and are able to control the quality of their wines because they own or manage the 5 vineyards that provide over 90% of their grapes. They are small enough to allow full attention to detail.
DESCRIPTION:	Black pepper, prune, raisin, oak and blackberry dominate the aroma profile of the 2007 Boeger El Dorado Zinfandel. Soft and supple throughout and a medium-bodied palate. Aging potential until 2012.
VARIETAL:	78% Zinfandel, 11% Petite Sirah, 9% Barbera, 2% Cabernet Sauvignon
COOPERAGE:	22 months in American and French Oak barrels.
