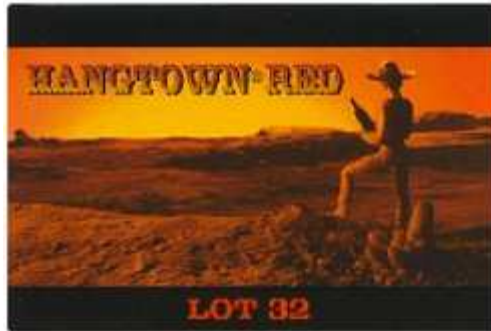


Boeger Winery: Hangtown Red Lot #37



WINERY:

Located in Placerville, the Boeger Winery is 15 minutes from where gold was first discovered in 1849. The subsequent rush to the foothills brought many miners and immigrants to the area. Boeger Winery sits on an 1850's ranch and winery homesteaded by the Fossati-Lombardo family. The original house, cellar, and distillery are still used today.

In 1972 Greg and Sue Boeger bought the property. In the three decades since then they have built on their education and experience and are able to control the quality of their wines because they own or manage the 5 vineyards that provide over 90% of their grapes. They are small enough to allow full attention to detail.

DESCRIPTION:

The name of this wine originates from gold rush days when Placerville was vying to become State Capitol and was responsible for meting out rough justice to the unruly miners.

Lots of varietals blended in here - fits right into barbeque season.

PICKING STATISTICS:

40% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc, 18% Pinot Noir, 8% Petite Sirah, 14% other!
