WINERY:

Chatom Vineyards is located in the breathtaking Esmeralda valley of the Sierra Foothills in Calaveras County. The valley was originally planted with low field crops, fruits and nut trees. When Gay Callan, owner and native San Franciscan, purchased the property in 1980, her vision was to plant a vineyard. The first vines were planted on 21 acres in 1981.

DESCRIPTION:

This Chardonnay has a wonderful nose - full of pears, melons, butter and cream with light rose. Creamy fruit on the palate blended by a smooth combination of peach, pear, vanilla and light citrus. A palate cleansing finish completes this Chardonnay.
