WINERY:

Located at 1300 feet, this beautiful 85 acre vineyard property bears mature fruit native to the great Rhône Valley. With these extraordinary grapes and winemaking expertise, David Girard Vineyards is dedicated to producing finely balanced wines reminiscent of those found in the Rhône Valley of Southern France.

DESCRIPTION:

It is quickly apparent that the fruit speaks to the quality of the wine in this refreshing Rhone blend. They have been creating this blend from the beginning. However, this vintage marks their first Viognier-Roussanne from El Dorado County fruit. Honeysuckle, apricot, and acacia blossoms dominate the aromas as the Roussanne softens the mouthfeel, adds viscosity and a touch of mineral and spice.
