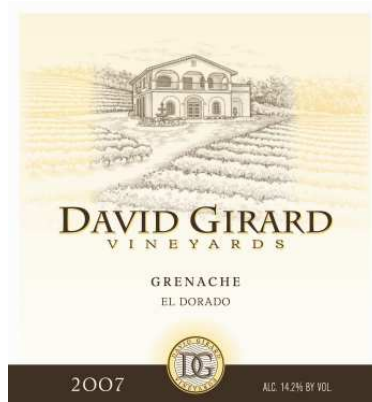


David Girard Vineyards

DESCRIPTION:

This vintage of Grenache begins with aromas of chewy strawberry, vanilla bean, cinnamon, and lavender-like herbs. A juicy core fills the mid palate. Hints of chocolate, vanilla and clove spice are developing in this new wine. This wine will drink best in 6 months to 2 years.
