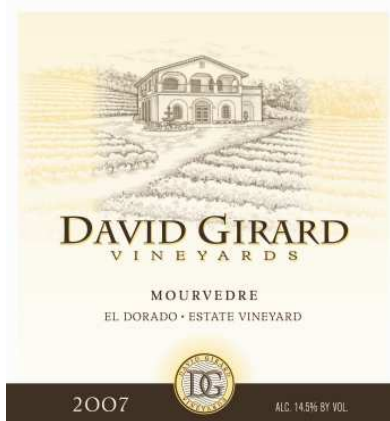


David Girard Vineyards

WINERY:

Located at 1300 feet, this beautiful 85 acre vineyard property bears mature fruit native to the great Rhône Valley. With these extraordinary grapes and winemaking expertise, David Girard Vineyards is dedicated to producing finely balanced wines reminiscent of those found in the Rhône valley of Southern France.

DESCRIPTION:

This wine has a wonderful balance between earth and fruit. Fresh earth scatters the aromas complimented by perfume, juicy red fruit, and cocoa. Flavors of dried black raspberries, chocolate, and bacon seamlessly continue on a velvety ribbon that expands the length of the tongue. Tannins are perfectly placed and hold the structure for extended aging.
