DESCRIPTION:	The estate Rosé is a brilliant blend of classic Rhône Varietals. This wine jumps out of the glass with guava, citrus, watermelon, and juniper. A full mouth-feel with soft edges and flavors of strawberry and tropical fruit, it finishes long with crisp acidity.
