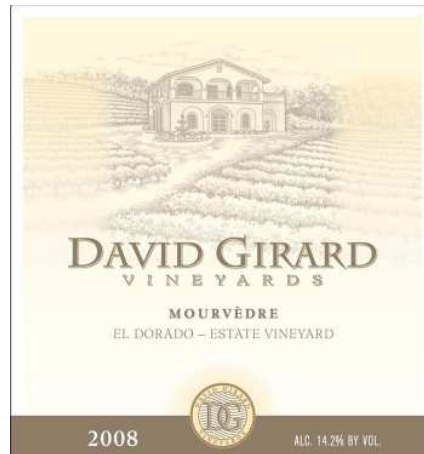


# David Girard Vineyards 2008 Mourvèdre

Located at 1300 feet, this beautiful 85 acre vineyard property bears mature fruit native to the great Rhône Valley. With these extraordinary grapes and winemaking expertise, David Girard Vineyards is dedicated to producing finely balanced wines reminiscent of those found in the Rhône Valley of Southern France.

## DESCRIPTION:

This wine is a balanced blend of dark raspberry, clove, tobacco, and earth. Echoes of minerality from wet stones alternate with oak derivatives. Bits of cocoa and violets playfully dance through fine grain tannins. Drink now or cellar until 2015
