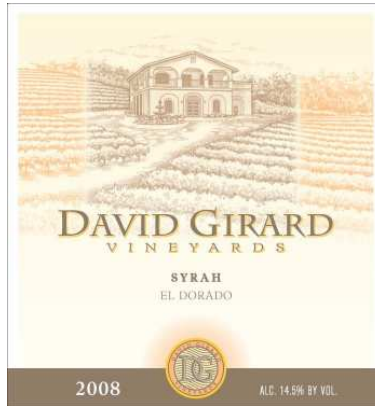


# David Girard Vineyards

### WINERY:

Located at 1300 feet, this beautiful 85 acre vineyard property bears mature fruit native to the great Rhone Valley. With these extraordinary grapes and winemaking expertise, David Girard Vineyards is dedicated to producing finely balanced wines reminiscent of those found in the Rhone valley of Southern France.

### DESCRIPTION:

Huge aromatics of blueberry, loganberry, tobacco, pepper, soy sauce and violets. Some nuances of oregano and peat moss define the earth tones. A lush mouth feel with well-structured tannins invites the most enthusiastic connoisseur to cellar for the next 5-7 years.

The grapes were hand harvested in September,, fermented for 17 days in small bins and aged in French Oak for 18 months..
