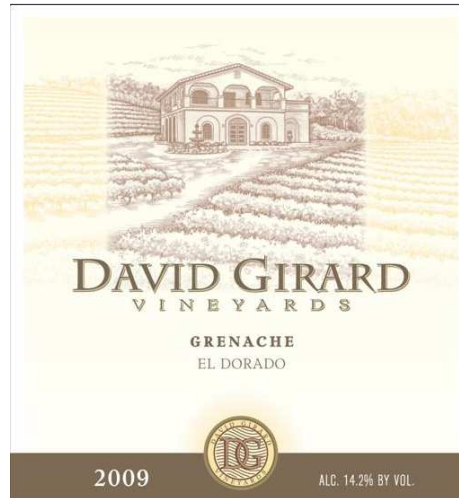


David Girard Vineyards

Located at 1300 feet, this beautiful 85 acre vineyard property bears mature fruit native to the great Rhône Valley. With these extraordinary grapes and winemaking expertise, David Girard Vineyards is dedicated to producing finely balanced wines reminiscent of those found in the Rhône valley of Southern France.

DESCRIPTION:

This vintage of Grenache begins with complex aromas of spice: clove, cinnamon and sweet anise. Big bright fruit, cola and black pepper show on the palate. Huge mouth feel with nicely placed tannins and big structure for all the fruit. Lasting fruit on the finish with sweet grapefruit to punctuate the intensity of the finish.
