

# 2007 Napa Valley Chardonnay

WINERY:	Located on Larkmead Lane just South of Calistoga, this winery was originally built in the 1800's. Formerly the Hans Kornel Winery that focused on Champagne, it is now owned by Richard Frank and is now primarily producing distinctive Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay.
DESCRIPTION:	Frank Family Vineyards' 2007 Napa Valley Chardonnay is multifaceted and vibrant; it opens with aromas of Kaffir lime leaves, yellow plum and dried pear. These bright aromas are countered by vanilla bean crème brûlée, lemon curd and cinnamon baked apple. The palate is lively, smooth and layered; bursting with pineapple, Bosc pear and Russet apples moving into spiced cake and buttery pie crust while being accented by a subtle hint of Thai ginger.
PRODUCTION:	19,656 Cases
PROCESS:	Barrel fermented and Sur Lie for 11 months with frequent batonage
APPELLATION:	100% Napa Valley Chardonnay
COOPERAGE:	Barrel fermented in 34% new and 66% once and twice filled French Oak barrels for 11 months.
ANALYSIS:	Alcohol 14.4%, pH 3.63, TA 0.68gm/100ml
BOTTLED:	August 2008
