- WINERY:** Located on Larkmead Lane just South of Calistoga, this winery was originally built in the 1800's. Formerly the Hans Kornel Winery that focused on Champagne, it was bought by Richard Frank and Koerner Rombauer in 1993. In 2007 Rich Frank took sole ownership. The winery is now primarily producing distinctive Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay and more recently Zinfandel.
- DESCRIPTION:** Frank Family Vineyards 2007 Napa Valley Zinfandel is a scarlet color with a dark purple hue. The aromas are vibrant, opening with juicy black cherries, raspberries, candied ginger and cinnamon sticks. Further depth evolves as aromas of blackberry pie, spice cake, white peppercorns and warm grilled figs emerge. The palate is abundant and layered; up front it is loaded with ripe fruit, chocolate and roasted nuts, followed by a chewy richness where dried fruit and sweet Asian spiced short ribs are uncovered. The structure is outstanding with complex tannins that provide exceptional weight and a long lingering finish.
- PRODUCTION:** 6,189 Cases
- APPELLATION:** Napa Valley. 84% Zinfandel, 9% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Petite Sirah,
- COOPERAGE:** Barrel aged for 15 months in 35% new and 65% once and twice filled French Oak barrels.
- ANALYSIS:** 15.0% alcohol by volume, TA 0.62 g/100ml, pH 3.79
- BOTTLED:** May 2009

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
