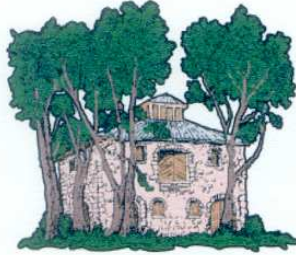


# Frank Family 2009 Carneros Pinot Noir

WINERY:	Located on Larkmead Lane just South of Calistoga, this winery was originally built in the 1800's. Formerly the Hans Kornel Winery that focused on Champagne, it is now owned by Richard Frank and primarily producing distinctive Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay. Visiting the Frank Family tasting room is a memorable experience that results in many loyal repeat customers.
DESCRIPTION:	Frank Family Vineyards' 2009 Carneros Pinot Noir has aromas that are lavish and diverse spanning delicate huckleberry and violet to toasted brown sugar, cherry spice, and smoked bacon. The palate is silky and elegant, yet powerful; it begins with a youthful expression of wild berries and cherry pie, moving into a fresh mid-palate boasting ripe plum and raspberry, and then into a well balanced finish that, while juicy and concentrated, expresses refined tannins.
