### WINERY:

Located on Larkmead Lane just South of Calistoga, this winery was originally built in the 1800's. Formerly the Hans Kornel Winery that focused on Champagne, it is now owned by Richard Frank and primarily producing distinctive Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay. More recently Zinfandel and Pinot Noir have been added to their primary offerings.

Visiting the Frank Family tasting room is a memorable experience that results in many loyal repeat customers.

### DESCRIPTION:

Rich dark garnet in color, the 2009 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon opens with savory notes of leather, spice and cedar that play nicely with the nuance of black cherries simmered in brown sugar. The palate is lavish and vibrant exploding with ripe red fruit, hibiscus flower, mocha and backed by a subtle minerality. This young wine impresses with its effortless elegance and complexity showing excellent mid palate structure and depth.

October 21st - October 30th, 2009

100% Napa Valley: 94 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 3% Merlot, 3% Petit Verdot,

### COOPERAGE:

20 months in a mixture of 30% New French Oak and 70% once and twice filled French Oak Barrels

17,887 cases

### ANALYSIS:

14.5 % alcohol, 3.71 pH, 0.61 gm/100ml TA
