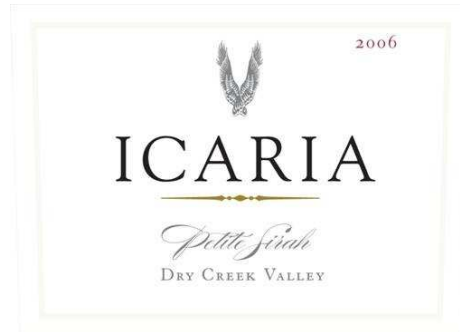


Icaria Creek Winery

2006 Dry Creek Petite Sirah



VINEYARDS:	Icaria Creek Winery is located at the Northern tip of Sonoma County. It is within the Alexander Valley appellation, which lies one and a half hours north of San Francisco. They call their micro-appellation, situated about 400 feet above sea level, the Asti Foothills. The vineyard estate is a fifty acre piece with twenty-six acres planted to Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, and Malbec.
DESCRIPTION:	Hillside Dry Creek valley is the place to be for Petite Sirah. The leaner hillside soils are needed to control this vigorous varietal, and it is worth it. Beautiful, dark, bittersweet, with vanilla cherry pie and wonderful exotic spice. With a good dose of black pepper, a quality most common to this powerful wine. Yes, you can make an elegant Petite Sirah!
