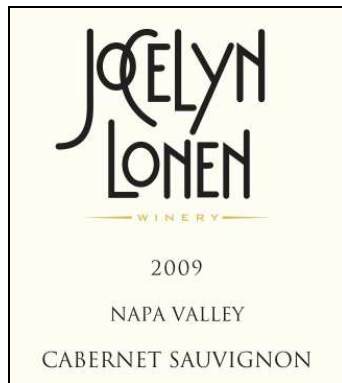


JOCELYN LONEN

2009 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon



- WINERY:** Lonen Curtis began planting vines and planning this winery in 1996. He subsequently worked with his daughter, Brandi Jocelyn Pack to develop and grow the winery that bears their names. Lonen passed away in 2004 but Brandi continues to lead the venture. Wines are currently made at the Laird Family Vineyard by resident winemaker Alison Doran.
- DESCRIPTION:** The 2009 vintage produced some of the best Cabernet Sauvignon to ever come out of the Napa valley. Well rounded yet concentrated with flavors of Bing cherry, strawberry, and currant. Wonderful balance between fruit and tannins. This wine continues to become more complex and will age nicely over the next 10-12 years.
- BLEND:** 95% Cabernet Sauvignon, 3% Cabernet Franc, 2% Malbec
- SOURCE:** Stagecoach, Krupp and Temple Vineyards
- COOPERAGE:** 90% French oak barrels, 10% American, 35% new
- HARVEST:** September/October 2009
- PRODUCTION:** 1000 cases
- ANALYSIS:** Alcohol 14.5%, pH 3.78, TA 0.58 gm/100ml
