

Mantra Wines

2004 Alexander valley Cabernet Sauvignon



- WINERY:** Mantra Wines have four Sonoma County vineyards - two in Alexander valley and two in Dry Creek valley, all producing world class and vineyard designated wines for noted wineries for many years. Starting in 2000, owners Lorene and Mike Kuimelis Sr. with Mike Jr. as winemaker have been producing stunning wines. The infinity sign that is their logo indicates that there is no finish: the taste goes on for ever.
- DESCRIPTION:** To make this great wine they selected grapes from the best blocks of their vineyard atop a ridge in the Mayacama mountain range at an elevation of 1,100 feet and blended them with grapes from selected blocks of their hillside vineyard overlooking the Russian River near the town of Asti. Five individual vineyard lots were fermented separately and then carefully blended to create a mosaic of flavors. This wine is primarily Cabernet Sauvignon (clone 337, clone 7) with 3% Merlot and was co-fermented with a small lot of their Cabernet from Big Ridge in Healdsburg resulting in a lush and concentrated wine of deep ruby/purple color with a rich forward palate and lengthy finish. The aromatics of this wine are reminiscent of currant, cherry and fruit cobbler.
- PRODUCTION:** xxx cases 750 ml
- BLEND:** 100% Estate fruit, 97% Cabernet Sauvignon, 3% Merlot from 2 estate vineyard sources - Revelations vineyard and Asti vineyard.
