A taste of Infinity

2006 Sonoma Cabernet Sauvignon



WINERY: Mantra Wines have four Sonoma County vineyards - two in Alexander valley and two in Dry Creek valley, all producing world class and vineyard designated wines for noted wineries for many years. Starting in 2000, owners Lorene and Mike Kuimelis Sr. with Mike Jr. as winemaker have been producing stunning wines. The infinity sign that is their logo indicates that there is no finish: the taste goes on for ever.

DESCRIPTION: Mantra's vineyards in the Alexander and Dry Creek valleys offer them the unique opportunity to create a complex wine showing the full spectrum of Sonoma County fruit. This wine is made from select blocks of the estate hillside vineyards located at elevations up to 1,100 feet. This wine is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from three of their distinct vineyard sites - two in the Alexander valley and one in the Dry Creek valley. The wines from each vineyard site were fermented separately, aged in a combination of coopers and later blended to achieve an exquisite example of Sonoma County Cabernet. This is a lusciously styled wine with fragrant aromas of dark ripe fruits such as blackberry and blueberry and accented with toasty oak overtones. On the palate the wine is rich, round and ripe with full-bodied flavors of cassis, blackberry, chocolate and caramel.

SOURCE STATISTICS: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon - 60% Alexander valley, 40% Dry Creek.

AGING Aged in French, Hungarian and American oak barrels.

ANALYSIS Alcohol 14.5% by volume

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
