2007 Mobius Cabernet Sauvignon Sonoma County



WINERY:	Mantra and Mobius Wines have four Sonoma County vineyards - two in Alexander valley and two in Dry Creek valley, all producing world class and vineyard designated wines for noted wineries for many years. Starting in 2000, owners Lorene and Mike Kuimelis Sr. with Mike Jr. as owner/winemaker have been producing stunning wines. The infinity sign that is their logo indicates that there is no finish to the wine: the taste goes on for ever.
DESCRIPTION:	This deep, dark and delicious wine is bursting with aromas of blackberry, currant, mulberry, caramel and spice. It is dense and rich on the pallet with a lusciousness and juicy structure that leaves you wanting for more.
NOTES:	A Mobius strip is an infinite, non-orientable loop.
HARVEST:	At 24.5 and 25.5 Brix 3.6pH
WINE MAKING:	Open and closed top fermentations.
BLEND:	90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Merlot, 5% Zinfandel
SOURCE STATISTICS:	Alexander valley, Dry Creek valley and Chalk Hill appellations
AGING	Aged 22 months in French, Hungarian, American barrels
ANALYSIS	14.6% alcohol by volume, TA 0.64gm/liter, pH 3.7
