WINERY:	Dr Richard (Grant) Peterson, Napa oenologist extraordinaire, discovered this grapevine in Wrotham (rot 'em) England. Originally brought to England by the Romans 2000 years ago, this turned out to have identical DNA to Pinot Noir. Dr Peterson established 4 acres of these grapes from which he makes a small quantity of sparkling blanc de noir.
DESCRIPTION:	The 2000 Wrotham Pinot is a sparkling blanc de noir made from the Wrotham Pinot grapes. It has a wonderfully romantic pink coloring, delightful nose enhanced by the tiniest of bubbles and the taste and finish to be expected by a Roman responsible for subduing the native british barbarians.
