WINERY:

Scott Harvey wines include three distinct brands: Scott Harvey Wines from Amador County, Jana Wines (Jana Harvey is Scott's wife) from Napa Valley and Super Hero Wines sourced from all over California. Scott advocated Barbera as the best grape to grow in the steep, mountainous terrain in the higher elevations of the Shenandoah valley of Amador County because Barbera originates in the foothills of the Alps in Piedmont (pied=foot; mont= hills), Italy. Amador county is extremely well suited to Barbera. Barbera both buds out earlier and ripens later than Zinfandel producing grapes at a lower pH and full bright varietal fruit. Barbera will eventually become known as the best variety for Amador County

DESCRIPTION:

Blackberry and raspberry blend into a bright center of cola, menthol and red licorice going into a full lingering finish.

BLEND:

94% Barbera, 5% Syrah, 1% Mixed Port. All Shenandoah Valley in Amador County Vineyards 30% Spinetta Vineyard, 31% Manby, 30% Lyman, 5% Chapman, 1% Clockspring.

COOPERAGE:

24 months in French oak
