WINERY:

Scott Harvey wines include three distinct brands: Scott Harvey Wines from Amador County, Jana Wines (Jana Harvey is Scott's wife) from Napa Valley and Super Hero Wines sourced from all over California. Scott advocated Barbera as the best grape to grow in the Sierra Foothills because Barbera originates in the foothills of the Alps in Piedmont (pied=foot; mont= hills), Italy. Amador county is extremely well suited to Barbera. Barbera both buds out earlier and ripens later than Zinfandel producing grapes at a lower pH and full bright varietal fruit. Barbera will eventually become known as the best variety for Amador County

DESCRIPTION:

Grown on steep, mountainous terrain in the higher elevations of the Shenandoah valley of Amador County, California, this mountain Selection Barbera is Scott Harvey's fastest growing, "rising star" wine. The J & S Reserve displays a fruit forward, rich full flavor expressing both the varietal and the Amador Terroir. This complex wine has notes of cherries, pepper and blackberry with a bright center finishing with vanilla and spice.

78.4% Harvey Vineyard Barbera, 21%% Manby Vineyard Zinfandel, 0.6% Clockspring mixed port varieties
