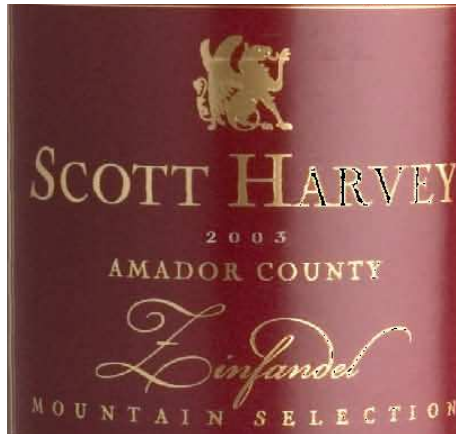


Scott Harvey Wines

WINERY	Scott Harvey wines include three distinct brands: Scott Harvey Wines from Amador County, Jana Wines (Jana Harvey is Scott's wife) from Napa Valley and Super Hero Wines sourced from all over California. Scott advocated Barbera as the best grape to grow in the Sierra Foothills because Barbera originates in the Foothills of the Alps in Piedmont Italy.
DESCRIPTION:	Forward and luscious, this lively, bold, red wine almost jumps out of the glass. Briary, blackberry extractive Amador Zinfandel gives the wine a good balance with firm tannins, complete with long lingering flavors of spice & cloves, bay leaf & holiday spices, raspberry tart, cherry cola showing good European style and drink.
PRODUCTION:	Produced from the vineyards located in the Fiddletown and Shenandoah valley appellations of Amador County. The granite soils of Amador County are well suited to producing distinctive, earthy, full bodied Zinfandels that have a wonderful character all to themselves.
SOURCES:	77% from Bowman Vineyard (33 years old), 8% Manby Vineyard, 8% Chapman Vineyard, 6% York Vineyard in Fiddletown, 1% Clockspring Vineyard.
BLEND:	85% Zinfandel, 14% Syrah, 1% Mixed Ports.
COOPERAGE:	12 months in French Oak
PRODUCTION:	1,975 cases @ 12/750ml
ANALYSIS	Alcohol 14.5%, TA .68, RS <04% dry; pH 3.61
