WINERY:	Vino Noceto is a family-run vineyard and wine business founded in 1984, in Amador County. They own nearly 40 acres of land now planted primarily with Sangiovese. They produce over 6000 cases of Sangiovese, Sangiovese Riserva, Rosato di Sangiovese and Moscato that they call Frivolo.
DESCRIPTION:	Cool, Delta breezes make for a crisp, aromatic, dry yet fruity version of this well-known Northern Italian varietal. Fruit-packed, easy-drinking, dry, aromatic and crisp. Perfect with spicy foods, Asian or Indian dishes, fish or light meats, or as a pre-dinner sipper.
PICKING STATISTICS	Grapes picked Sept. 7, 2009. 10.36 tons Pinot Grigio, Lambert Ranch, Clarksburg.
COOPERAGE:	Gently crushed and pressed into stainless steel tank, cool fermentation at 65-70 degrees Fahrenheit, 10+ days. Cold and heat stabilized. Stainless, until December bottling
PRODUCTION:	728 cases, 750 mL
ANALYSIS:	Alcohol 13% by volume; RS less than .25%.
